

**T**his brand new marina on the south-west coast of Italy is attracting boat owners from all over Europe thanks to its stunning location, state-of-the-art facilities and world-class design. Its position at the gateway to the Amalfi coastline and the island of Capri makes it a must-see destination for visiting boats and an attractive long-term proposition for UK and European-based owners looking for a new berth in a convenient location.

**LOCATION**

Situated in the Gulf of Salerno, 60km south of Naples and only a stone's throw from Salerno airport, Marina d'Arechi is easily reached by plane, car or boat. Once you're there many of Italy's most beautiful cruising destinations await. To the west lie the historic coastal towns of Amalfi and Positano and the unspoiled island of Capri, to the south, Agropoli, Punta Licosa and the stunning Aeolian islands lead the more adventurous boat owner down to Sicily itself.

**CRUISING AREA**

With a season that stretches from April to November, an average eight hours of sunshine a day and water temperatures that rarely drop below 25°C, this is fair-weather boating at its best. Even by Mediterranean standards, the Gulf of Salerno is an exceptional cruising area thanks to the calm waters of the Tyrrhenian Sea, the dramatic coastal scenery and some of the finest cuisine and culture in the whole of Italy. From the colourful medieval towns clinging to the cliffs to the pristine beaches and bays of the Amalfi coastline, there is a lifetime's worth of cruising within a few hours' relaxed motoring of your marina berth.

**FACILITIES**

Marina d'Arechi is more than just a nice place to keep your boat, it's an entire coastal community that has been designed from the ground-up to provide every amenity a boat owner could possibly wish for. Built on a man-made island and connected to the mainland with an elegant suspension bridge, it will incorporate shops, bars, restaurants, parkland, a sports centre, beauty spa, baby club, swimming pool and a stunning four-storey yacht club that arches over the sea like a giant, white leaf. Every berth is equipped with drinking water and reliable shorepower connections while marina facilities include a 220-tonne travel lift, on-site engineers, 24-hour security patrols and a state-of-the-art fuel berth. To date over €120 million has been invested into this remarkable new boating hub.

**BERTHING COSTS**

Capable of accommodating almost 1,000 craft of all shapes and sizes from 10m sportsboats to 100m megayachts, Marina d'Arechi is set to become one of the largest and most desirable marinas in the whole of the Mediterranean. The first 480 berths have just been released and with options ranging from daily visitor rates to 79-year leases demand is strong. An annual berth for a 46ft (14m) boat works out at €7,850 with overnight stays from as little as €55 but any MBY reader who applies for a berth during the London Boat Show (January 12-20, 2013) is being offered a special 10% discount.
