

Easily reached from the UK, you'll be spoilt for choice of stunning spots and first-class facilities at St Helier Marina







With a warmer climate than the mainland and a plethora of stunning coves, Jersey is boating heaven

For South Coast boat owners looking to expand their horizons, Jersey is the perfect destination. Close enough to be within easy reach but far enough for every trip to feel like an adventure, it combines all the advantages of a sunnier overseas location with the comforts of home. There are no language or currency issues to deal with, just a warm welcome from this boat-friendly corner of the British Isles. And thanks to the low-duty fuel you can use your boat to its full potential without breaking the bank.

LOCATION

Situated in the heart of Jersey's capital, St Helier Marina is just a short walk from the bustling town centre with its world-class shops, restaurants and entertainment. Just as importantly, it's only a 15-minute taxi ride from Jersey's main airport with direct flights to dozens of regional airports including Southampton, Bristol, Exeter, Birmingham, Manchester, Glasgow and Liverpool as well as most of London's major airports. Fast ferries from Portsmouth, Poole and Weymouth also dock at the nearby Port of Jersey.

CRUISING AREA

The Channel Islands are widely acknowledged as some of the finest cruising grounds in Europe. Their location 100 miles south of the British mainland enjoys higher average temperatures and longer sun hours than the rest of the UK, while the dramatic coastline is dotted with sheltered coves and beautiful beaches where boats can lie at anchor. The Island's rich history ensures there's just as much to enjoy on land as there is at sea, including the fascinating war tunnels, the world renowned Durrell Wildlife Conservation Trust and dozens of

spectacular coastal walks. From miles of sandy beaches to secret anchorages and sheltered lagoons only accessible by boat, there's an entire lifetime's worth of cruising in the Channel Islands alone not to mention the many delights of the neighbouring Brittany coast that lies just 14nm from your doorstep.

FACILITIES

Tucked behind a protective sill and accessible for three hours either side of high water, St Helier Marina's floating pontoons enjoy the natural rise and fall of the tide without the extreme 12m range experienced in some parts of the Island. All the berths are equipped with fresh water and electricity as well as free Wi-Fi coverage and access to the sparkling shower and toilet facilities. Just outside the marina a 150m-long waiting pontoon ensures you're never caught out by the tides, with a fuel berth to keep the tanks topped up with low-duty diesel. Tall sandstone walls and 24-hour CCTV watched over by the friendly staff at the Marine Leisure Centre make this an exceptionally safe place to leave your boat all year round.

BERTHING COSTS

St Helier Marina has over 200 berths for craft of all different sizes. The annual berthing rate of £353.23 per metre compares favourably with South Coast marinas, while short stays for 12-14m craft start at £33.50 per night or £201 for the week.
