### CHAPTER 2, WEATHER

Para 2, delete in toto, substitute: DP07 broadcasts (Mar 25th to Oct 1st, in German): gale and strong wind warnings on receipt. At 0745, 0945, 1245, 1645 and 1945 LT, for Fisher, German Bight and Humber, DP07 broadcasts a synopsis, 12-hour forecast, 24 hrs outlook, coastal station reports. 4–5 day outlook for the North Sea (and Baltic) at 0945, 1645 and 1945.

DP07 also broadcasts the shipping forecast on short wave at 0930 and 1400LT, 7310 kHz and 9560 kHz. There is no Sunday forecast at 1400 on 7310 kHz.

**101, Radio broadcasting: Nord Deutscher Rundfunk (NDR)**

sub-heading: **NDR 1 Welle Nord (FM)**, amend: **NDR info (FM)**; delete: all after line 1, substitute: SW N Sea, German Bight, Fisher, Utsire, Skagerrak are broadcast after the news 0900 (Sun only), 1006, 1300, 1906, 2200 LT and, if time slots permit, between programmes: **Aurich** 96·4 Mhz; **Bremen** 95·0 Mhz; **Bremerhaven** 98·9 Mhz; **Cuxhaven** 93·1 Mhz; **Hamburg** 92·3 MHz; **Heide** 87·9 MHz; **Helgoland** 92·5 MHz; **Morsum (Sylt)** 92·7 MHz; **Papenburg** 100·2 Mhz.

**102, Radio Bremen MW and FM**, delete in toto, substitute: new heading: **Digital radio (DAB+only)**, and new para: Shipping forecasts are broadcast (in German) daily by **DRadio Dok Deb**, (Deutschland Radio Documente und Debatten) at 0105, 0640, 1810LT and **NDR Info Spezial**, at 0005, 0830, 2205LT. Both stations are also available via satellite (DVB-S via Astra).

**102, Heading, amend: Recorded telephone forecasts**

Delete in toto, substitute: Call ☎ +49 (0)69 8062 6101 (H24) for the latest wind warnings (> F6) for individual North Sea areas. If no warning is in force, a wind forecast for German Bight and W/S Baltic is provided.

Alternatively, call ☎ +49 (0)69 8062 5799 (H24) then select/press the marine weather options shown below:

- 1 for the general situation report.
- 2 for the SW North Sea, German Bight and Fisher.
- 3 for the Skagerrak and Kattegat.
- 4 for the Baltic Sea.
- 5 for the German N Sea coast.
- 6 for the German Baltic coast.
